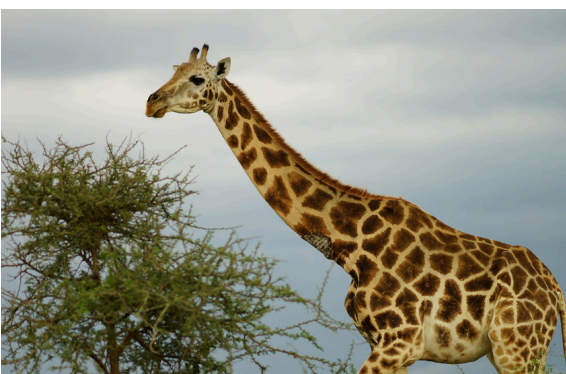
## Take care of adorable babies

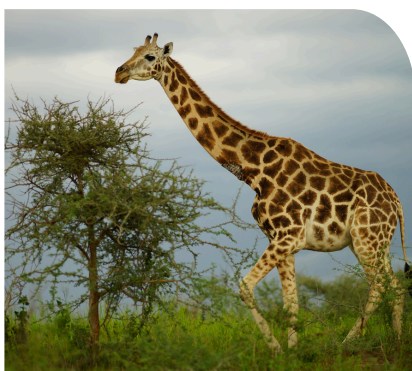

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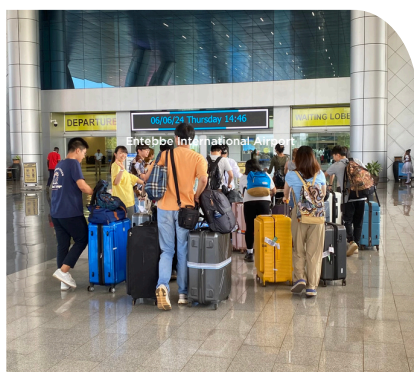

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# Travel Expenses

**Total cost per person approx. HK\$25,000**

**Single Room Surcharge HK\$6,000**

**What's Included:** Accommodation (hotel room with twin / three beds), transportation, meals mentioned in the itinerary, daily bottled water, related administrative fee and Travel Industry Council of Hong Kong stamp duty (only applicable to departure from Hong Kong)

**What's not included :** Round trip flight ticket, fuel surcharges and airport taxes, self-paid meals mentioned in the itinerary, single room surcharges, travel insurance, entry visas, vaccinations and related drugs, virus testing, etc.

A minimum of 15 participants is required for the group. If the final number of participants is under 15, the cost per person will be adjusted. We will notify each participant the latest update regarding the fees two weeks after the registration deadline. If the participants agree to proceed, we will continue the trip as planned. If the group fails to form, a refund will be made to the participant. The tour fee may fluctuate depending on the air ticket price, exchange rate, itinerary and other factors.

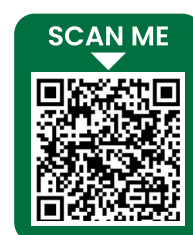

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# Important Notes

## Target Audience:

Anyone who is interested to see the work of Watoto first-hand and is willing to participate in the volunteering service.

## Age: No age limit

Participants under the age of 15 must be accompanied by their parents/guardians. Participants who are under 18 years but over 15 years must obtain a consent form completed and signed by their parents/guardians before they can participate.

## Language Requirements:

English is the main language in Uganda. Basic English communication skill is sufficient.

## Fundraising for the community/Watoto Village

We hope that each participant can raise HK\$5000 (adults)/HK\$3,000 (students) for Watoto Child Care Ministries, which will be used for the construction of Watoto Village or community (including building houses, classrooms, roads, and other infrastructures), education, medical and other ministries. Basic construction such as water, electricity, sewage, trails, roads and community facilities are vital for our village and the community. Those who donate over HK\$100 will receive a tax-deductible receipt.

## Entry Visa:

Participants must apply for an Uganda entry visa online by themselves, and the visa fee (about USD50) should be paid by the participant. We can provide supporting documents and the itinerary for participants to apply for a visa. If participates is with HKSAR passport is visa free.

## Pre-departure Meeting:

There will be a pre-departure preparation meeting before departure. All participants are required to attend. Overseas participants can also join online. The details will be provided later.



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# Important Notes

## Vaccinations and Medications

Vaccination against yellow fever is an entry requirement for travellers to Uganda. Other vaccinations and oral malaria prophylaxis are also necessary. Participants **are required to** make an appointment with the Travel Health Center of the Department of Health for vaccination and acquire the medication.

The yellow fever vaccine is only available at the Travel Health Centres of the Department of Health in Hong Kong. Clinics and hospitals do not offer yellow fever vaccinations.

Due to the large number of tourists visiting the Travel Health Centre for vaccinations and the limited daily consultation quota, please call the Travel Health Centre ahead of time **before signing up for the tour** to make an appointment for the vaccinations. People over the age of 60 receiving the yellow fever vaccine for the first time will have certain health risks. Before registering, it is strongly advised to contact the Travel Health Centre and make an appointment with a doctor to seek medical advice.

If the participant is unable to participate in the trip due to failure to receive the yellow fever vaccine, the organisation will make arrangements in accordance with the Terms and Condition 2. Cancellation, withdrawal and refund.

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# Terms and Conditions

## 1. General rules

1. Participants should submit the application form before the deadline, followed by attending interviews arranged by our Watoto Asia office.
2. Pay the tour fee in full to 'Explore & Discover Travel (HK) Ltd' before the specified date. (Please refer to the registration procedure for details)
3. Participants must hold valid travel documents and Uganda travel visas, which must be valid for six months or more from the date of departure.
4. If the tour payment is not made before the specified date, the participant's spot will be cancelled and the relevant deposit will be not refunded.
5. Shared room arrangements are only limited to people of the same sex, couples or family members.
6. All the accommodation arrangements are made in accordance with the itinerary, and the organisation reserves the right to make changes depending on the prevailing circumstances.
7. Luggage: Each participant can carry a maximum of 15-20 kg of check-in luggage for the round trip (the confirmed maximum check-in weight allowance will be notified in the second pre-departure meeting). If the weight of the participant's luggage is less than the maximum weight allowance, the remaining weight allowance will be reserved for the transportation of supplies for the organisation.

## 2. Cancellation, withdrawal and refund

1. The minimum number of participants in this tour: 10 full participants. The tour fee will be adjusted if the number of participants does not meet the minimum number of participants. We will notify the latest fee two weeks after the registration deadline. If the participants agree, we will continue to arrange the relevant itinerary. If the tour cannot be formed, we will refund the tour fees. The tour fee may be adjusted based on air ticket prices, exchange rates, itinerary and any other factors that affect the cost.
2. If participants withdraw from the tour due to personal reasons, they must provide the organisation in a written notice. The cancellation date will be based on the time when the organisation responds to confirm the receipt. If there is any special circumstances, participants can apply to transfer the tour fee to new participants, but the organisation will only consider acceptance on a case-by-case basis and additional administrative fees will be charged.

Cancellation charges and refunds will apply based on the following conditions:

- Cancellation more than 60 days prior to departure: The organisation will refund the tour fee, but will deduct HK\$10,000.
- Cancellation between 31 and 60 days prior to departure: The organisation will refund the tour fee, but will deduct HK\$12,500.
- Cancellation 30 days or less prior to departure: The tour fee is non-refundable.

\*Ticket refund arrangements are subject to the airline's terms and conditions. For details, please refer to the seat confirmation email.

\*Refunds must be processed through the bank and will take up to one month.

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# Terms and Conditions

3. According to the Travel Industry Council of Hong Kong Directive No. 223 on "Members Cancel Tour Due to Reasons Beyond Control", if a travel agency cancels a tour due to "reasons beyond control" #, the company will deduct the levy due to the cancellation of the tour. The refund and handling fees include transportation, accommodation, tickets, etc.\*, and the remaining balance will be refunded within one month. #According to Directive No. 177, "reasons beyond control" mean hostilities, political unrest, terror attacks, natural disasters, pestilences, bad weather, technical problems to transport, changes to the frequency/timetable of any means of conveyance by its operator without advance notice, strikes, industrial action, travel advisories (warnings) issued by governments of the destinations/the World Health Organisation, red/black outbound travel alerts issued by the Hong Kong SAR Government, and any other situations of which the industry has no control and which are unfavourable to outbound trips of travellers.

## **3. Liability clauses**

1. The tour use group transportation tickets, and tour members must travel with the group. If a member leaves the group or abandons the itinerary during the trip, the remaining fees will not be refunded. They are solely responsible for leaving the group. The organisation and its entrusted organisations is not held responsible for all consequences. If a tour member is unable to meet the pre-arranged transportation or accommodation for any reason, the tour member shall be responsible for any indirect or direct expenses or losses.

2. If the tour members request before departure that they would like to depart on their own and return to Hong Kong individually, the organisation will be happy to assist. For terms, please refer to the itinerary of their registered tour. However, it depends on the final decision of the transportation provider whether the transportation arrangement is confirmed or not. Indirect or direct costs or losses must be borne by the tour members themselves, and the organisation is not responsible.

3. All air tickets, ferry tickets, train tickets, accommodation or sightseeing items arranged in the itinerary are group reservations. Once confirmed and ordered in Hong Kong, no money will be refunded to those who cannot use it under any circumstances.

4. In the event of special circumstances beyond the control of the organisation, such as traffic delays, natural disasters, wars, political unrest, bad weather, typhoons, technical problems with transportation, industrial action, loss of documents, strikes, etc., the itinerary must be changed or any programme must be cancelled, any additional expenses or losses incurred must be borne and paid by the tour members themselves. Tour members are not allowed to object or withdraw for any reason, or demand refund or compensation for unfinished itineraries.

5. If a tour member is refused by the immigration bureau at the time of entry, our organisation is not held responsible, and the remaining trip expenses will not be refunded. All additional expenses arising therefrom, such as transportation, accommodation arrangements, etc., must be borne by the tour members themselves, and the organisation will not be held responsible.



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# Terms and Conditions

6. Under special circumstances, the organization reserves the right to cancel or replace any tour itinerary before or after departure, and also reserves the right to shorten or extend the itinerary. In this case, the fee will be increased or decreased as appropriate, and members cannot object or withdraw for any reason.

7. The transportation, accommodation, meals, tourist attractions or entertainment items arranged by the organisation on behalf of the members are not owned, managed or operated by the organisation. All the above-mentioned arrangements made by the organization on behalf of the members, or any tickets, exchange documents, receipts, contracts or bills, etc. issued on behalf of the above-mentioned service agencies, are issued in accordance with the rules and terms pre-established by the above-mentioned service agencies. If members encounter traffic delays, baggage loss, accidental casualties, property losses, etc., they should directly negotiate or seek compensation from the organisation that owns, manages or operates the relevant means of transportation, accommodation, restaurants, tourist spots or entertainment projects in accordance with local laws. The organisation with not held responsible Members can inquire about the relevant service agencies from the organisation.

8. If a tour member encounters an emergency or is unable to follow the tour itinerary for any reason, the organisation must consider the environment and situation, as well as the safety and interests of other tour members, before deciding whether the tour escort/tour guide should accompany the tour member to stay. The tour member shall not object or demand compensation. In addition, if a tour member encounters an emergency or is unable to follow the itinerary for any reason, the remaining unused scenic spot sightseeing, itinerary, hotel accommodation, meals, transportation and flight arrangements will be borne by the tour member. No refunds or compensation will be made. If the tour member needs assistance from our staff during the trip or after the tour, any additional expenses incurred will be borne by the member.

9. Tour members must abide by the regulations of various governments and are strictly prohibited from carrying contraband. Violators must bear all responsibilities.

10. All accommodations are arranged according to the itinerary, but the organisation reserves the right to make changes based on the prevailing circumstances and provide accommodation of the same level.

11. If any tour member hinders regular activities and interest of the tour, or slanders or insults other tour members and service personnel in actions or words, the tour escort has the right to cancel his or her qualification to join the tour depending on the specific circumstances and will not to refund any fees. Any tour members under the age of 18 who are under the supervision of the tour member must also leave the tour, and the organisation is not held responsible for all their activities after leaving the tour.

12. Before joining the our tour, participants should read the relevant travel advice. However, whether to participate in the tour is purely a personal decision. In this case, any member who decides to withdraw from the group will be deemed to have given up, and the refund of the tour fees will be arranged according to the registration instructions and Terms and Conditions 2. Cancellation withdrawal and refund.

13. Our Organisation reserves the right to require participants who are underage or over 65 years old or have chronic diseases to present a signed health certificate by a registered doctor in Hong Kong.
